ISWCC

Katie Yoder reported that the WQPA grant is accepting proposals. Currently there is no cap on the funds per proposal and there is only a 25% match requirement. The work done under WQPA needs to be completed by June of 2023 so, smaller projects are encouraged.

DEQ

Todd Higens with DEQ reported that the §319 grant application is open April 14-July 12, 2022. Todd discussed how he made the story map for the Hangman Creek Watershed priority areas. The Board discussed with Todd a possible §319 proposal to replace undersized culverts. Additional culverts would also be added. The goal of this roadwork in Benewah County is to protect the Hangman Creek watershed from harmful sediment loading.

BSWCD

Kylie Daman reported to board the final number of seedlings that were sold and the estimated income. She is continuing work on the crop sign sleeves. Once planting begins Kylie will work with Tami with FSA to place the crop signs. She informed the board the Shoshone and Benewah County request for funds in FY23 are ready to be signed and invoices have been created. She updated the board that the §319 project for the St. Joe River bid requests have been sent out. If they come back high again the District can apply for WQPA funds to cover the difference. Kylie asked the Board if they wanted to start having dinner at the monthly meetings again, the Board decided against that as long as the meeting remained at 5:00 PM.
